Susan is a barrister specialising in sports law, investigations and regulation, an accredited mediator, and commercial arbitrator. She is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators and former Chair of the Sports Law Bar Association of Ireland. She is an arbitrator at the Court of Arbitration for Sport and was appointed to the CAS Anti-Doping Division for the Tokyo Olympic Games. Susan is the Independent Judicial Chair of World Wheelchair Rugby, the Independent Deputy Chair of the Irish Horseracing Regulatory Authority Appeals Board and member of the British Horseracing Authority Appeal Panel. She was formerly Head of Legal and Legislative Affairs for World Rugby and General Counsel of Rugby World Cup Limited.
